




Total Headcount and FTE Fall Semester 2005-2014




TCSG Enrollment and FTE


National Enrollment by Sector: Percent Change from Previous Year


Enrollment Change and Population Growth


Percent Full-Time, 2005-2014




Enrollment by Student Level, 2005-2014






First-Time Freshmen, 2005-2014


Undergraduate Transfers, 2005-2014

Dual Enrollment 2005-2014








Non-Traditional Undergraduates by Sector, 2005-2014




Students by Race and Ethnicity, 2009-2014






Race and Ethnicity by Sector, 2014






Enrollment by Residency, 2005-2014






Residency by Sector, 2014






Percent Out-of-State Students Receiving Waiver




Enrollment by Gender, 2005-2014






Percent Male by Sector, 2005-2014




