




State University 6year Graduation Rates based on hours enrolled in First Semester




Freshmen Enrolled in at least 15 hours






System Comparison of Success in Gateway English Classes





Students with at least a C grade in MATH1001, 1101 or 1111







USG System-wide Comparison of Success in Gateway Math Classes Disaggregated by Institution







Origin
